Update to the following items below:

New membership prices for 2017 are:

Regular members - **\$900/yr** (\$225/Q)

Honorary members, Executive officers and Committee members - **\$575/yr** (\$143.75/Q)

Lifetime members - **\$0**

Payments are due when each quarter begins. Late payments are subject to a \$50 fine.

Club News!

On January 13th a “General Membership” meeting was held to discuss membership pricing for 2017. At this meeting the following items were voted on and passed:

- 1) **\$50** increase to membership fee (\$850 to \$900). The increase is comprised of \$25 towards “dues” & \$25 towards annual operating expenses (i.e. insurance, taxes, ...etc)
- 2) **\$5** increase to locker fees which will now reflect the following amounts: \$40/\$55/\$75.
- 3) A **\$25** increase to “party event credits” (**\$50 to \$75**). Credits can be used partially (in increments of \$25) or all at once.

Update to the following items below:

Super Bowl Party - February 5th

Bar Chairman Tom Halpin will once again host the annual Super Bowl party from 6pm until ½ hour after the game. Cost includes open bar and food. Pricing is as follows:

Sign-up by 1/29: **\$30**

Sign-up from 1/30 thru 2/4: **\$35**

Sign-up on 2/5: **\$40**

Outdoor Pool

An application for a pool permit with the City of New York is in progress. At the 1/13/17 membership meeting, the members authorized the payment of the \$1980 application fee along with an approval for additional expenses (engineering fees, parts, ..etc) that will be needed in the coming months. A pre-approval of up to \$6000 in expenses has been authorized at this point in time.

The engineer has drawn up and provided all necessary blueprints/specifications that will be needed in order for us to be up to code with NYC. A Certificate of Occupancy (C/O) is also being obtained.

The WCFC Executive Board is hopeful that all pool modifications, permits and certificates are completed and obtained in a timely fashion so the pool can be open for this upcoming summer season. Please know that the timeliness of permits and certificates from NYC are out of our control.
